The truth about Seuss is at last on the loose

Dr. Seuss exhibition reveals the man

"Oh, the places you'll go!
There is a fox in the door!"

One of the places to go for "Seuss-ter" this month is the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, where the exhibition "The Art of Dr. Seuss: A Retrospective and National Touring Exhibition" runs 10 a.m.-6 p.m. daily, Saturday-Aug. 17 at Modern Gallery, 629 Broadway, San Francisco 94133 (S.F.). www.sfmoma.org/seuss

The exhibition, which opens Saturday and runs for a month, consists of 10 panels containing 100 images and includes many works — illustrations, sculpture and all paintings — of the noted children's book writer and illustrator, including his early years in advertising, editorial cartoons, World War II political cartoons, and of course, from his 44 children's books.

One of the parts from last night had some fascinating articles "Seven Art Collaborations" written. Geisel's father was a biologist who sometimes brought some animal parts. In the 1950s, Geisel compiled a "Collection of Unorthodox Taxidermies," in which he put together parts of these different animals into new configurations such as the "Antelopian Gazelle," the "Two Horned Triceratops" and the "Hillbilly

was the "Wrong Side of the Street" that depicts a cigarette-smoking, pool-playing killer wearing a beret and a wide-brimmed hat. Geisel was born in 1904 in Springfield, Mass. after graduating from Dartmouth College in 1925, he went to Oxford University for a doctorate in literature, mostly to please his father. However, Geisel didn't complete his doctorate and later joked that he added "Dr." to his name in place because his father always wanted one in the family and he'd send his father a lot of money by just calling himself a doctor rather than going to medical school. In 1927, Geisel was where he met Helen Palmer, whom he married and who had suggested he become an illustrator.

Upon returning from Europe in 1927, Geisel began submitting articles and cartoons to publications, including Life, Vanity Fair, the Saturday Evening Post, and a humor magazine called Judge. But most of his income came

from his "writing" in the fiction of the day's magazines to write and illustrate. And to think that I live in a Midwestern town," which was repeated more than 20 times before a friend at Vanguard Press published it for him, where it went on to moderate success.

Geisel served in the Army Signal Corps during World War II, where he found animation and developed a series of training films featuring a character called Private Snafu, for which he won the Legion of Merit. During this period, he also created documentaries like "The Story of the United States" and "Design for Death" and a cartoon called "Geisel's Living Thing," which also won him an Oscar.

In 1939, after Life Magazine published a report on literary young schoolteachers, two publishers, Houghton Mifflin (Cranston Press) and Random House, teamed up and asked Geisel to write and illustrate a children's primer using only 22 "basic words" vocabulary words. Just months later, "The Cat in the

"Hat" was published. It became an instant success.

According to one of the most famous Seuss legends, in 1960 publisher Bennett Cerf had Geisel \$50 that he couldn't write an entire book using only 55 words. Seuss wrote "Green Eggs and Ham," but Cerf, disappointed, never paid the \$50.

In 1967, Helen Geisel died. In 1968, Theodor Geisel married an old friend, Audrey Stone. Several years after Geisel's death in 1991, Audrey Geisel began making

some of his hundreds of private art works available to the public.

The Seuss exhibition features a note from her "I remember her telling Ted that there would never be a day when some of his paintings would be seen, and he would then share with his son-in-law, another part of himself — his private self. That day has come. I am glad."

William W. Dwyer, the exhibition's curator and self-proclaimed "Seussologist," devoted seven years to researching and putting

together the project, which includes works from the London House Museum, Presidential Library.

"Geisel single-handedly forged a new genre of art that falls somewhere between the Surrealist Movement of the early 20th century and the inspired nonsense of a child's classroom doodle," Dwyer said.

Only a Grinch could disagree.
