by supporters as the Dutch Dreyfus All three figures have been vilified and mythologized out of a never ending need Ian Buruma argues to see history and particularly war and above all World War II as a neat story of angels and devils The Collaborators is a fascinating reconstruction of what in fact we can know about these incredible figures and what will always remain out of reach What emerges is all the more mesmerizing for being painted in chiaroscuro In times of life and death stakes the truth quickly gets buried under lies and self deception Now when demagogues abroad and at home are assaulting the truth once more the stories of the collaborators and their lessons are indispensable
