Selling, 2016 Traditionally Catholic moral theology has been based upon an approach that over emphasized the role of normative ethics and subsequently associated moral responsibility with following or disobeying moral rules Reframing Catholic Theological Ethics offers an alternative ethical method which without destroying any of the valuable insights of normative ethics reorients the discipline to consider human motivation and intention before investigating behavioral options for realizing one's end Evidence from the New Testament warrants the formation of a teleological method for theological ethics which is further elaborated in the approach taken by Thomas Aquinas Unfortunately the insights of the latter were misinterpreted at the time of the counter reformation Joseph A Selling's analysis of moral theological textbooks demonstrates the entrenchment of a normative method aimed at identifying sins in service to the practice of sacramental confession With a firm basis in the teaching of Vatican II the human person integrally and adequately considered provides the fundamental criterion for approaching ethical issues in the contemporary world The perspective then turns to the crucial question of describing the ends or goals of ethical living by providing a fresh approach to the concept of virtue Selling concludes with suggestions about how to combine normative ethics with this alternative method in theological ethics that begins with the actual ethical orientation of the human person toward virtuous living

*Beyond Virtue Ethics* Stephen M. Meawad, 2023-05-01 A contemporary model of spiritual struggle shifts the emphasis from virtue's acquisition to its pursuit. *Beyond Virtue Ethics* offers a distinctive approach to virtue ethics, arguing not simply for the importance of struggle to virtue ethics but that struggle itself is a manifestation of virtue. In doing this, Stephen M. Meawad offers a way of thinking about virtue not simply as a perfected state but as a state that is to a greater or lesser degree a manifestation of the ideal itself, which is not attainable. Meawad affirms the concept of the unity of virtues, that is, the idea that a virtue is not a virtue unless united with other perfected virtues, which is found in God. Insofar as humans grow in unity with God, they too participate in the unity of virtues, although always to an imperfect extent. Meawad rejects a division between ethics and spirituality and provides two concrete examples of this suggested model. The first is the application of this model to the body and its implications for contemporary sexual ethics. The second is a reintegration of ethics and Scripture through the contemporary application of an ancient Patristic divine reading. This book establishes for readers a contemporary model of spiritual struggle, defining it as the exertion of effort in all conceivable dimensions: physical, emotional, psychological, and intellectual, with the intent to attain a semblance of knowledge of and intimacy with Jesus Christ.

**Aquinas's Eschatological Ethics and the Virtue of Temperance** Matthew

Levering, 2019-11-15 Matthew Levering offers a biblical and Thomistic portrait of the cardinal virtue of temperance and its allied virtues in dialogue with an ecumenical range of theologians and scholars. In *Aquinas's Eschatological Ethics and the Virtue of Temperance*, Levering argues that Catholic ethics make sense only in light of the biblical worldview that Jesus has inaugurated the kingdom of God by pouring out his spirit. Jesus has made it possible for us to know and obey God's law for human flourishing as individuals and communities. He has reoriented our lives toward the goal of beatific communion with him in charity, which affects the exercise of the moral virtues that pertain to human flourishing. Without the context of the inaugurated kingdom, Catholic ethics as traditionally conceived will seem like an effort to find a middle ground between

legalistic rigorism and relativistic laxism which is especially the case with the virtue of temperance the focus of Levering's book After an opening chapter on the eschatological biblical character of Catholic ethics the ensuing chapters engage Aquinas's theology of temperance in the Summa theologiae which identifies and examines a number of virtues associated with temperance Levering demonstrates that the theology of temperance is profoundly biblical and that Aquinas's theology of temperance relies for its intelligibility upon Christ's inauguration of the kingdom of God as the graced fulfillment of our created nature The book develops new vistas for scholars and students interested in moral theology

Natural Law & the Secular Mythos Gregory Morgan, 2025-02-20 This book argues that natural law when construed as an epistemological and trans-cultural lingua franca adjudged capable of legitimating the rational intelligibility and universal applicability of specific Christian moral principles within contemporary secular discourse has failed Through a detailed analysis of the contributions of three prominent natural law theorists who are located within a shared philosophical theological tradition namely John Finnis Jean Porter and John Milbank the text illuminates the extent to which this failure is as much intramural as it is extramural Morgan explores how new horizons open up for natural law if the theological unsaid's are allowed to surface and the disremembering power of the secular mythos is overcome The final chapter's of the book addresses one such horizon that the theoretical fulcrum of the natural law lies not in its perceptual self-evidence or in its immanent secularity but rather in its subtle provision of an immanent eschatology

*Biblical Natural Law* Matthew Levering, 2008-03-21. Natural law theory is controversial today because it presumes that there is a stable human nature that is subject to a law. How do we know that human nature is stable and not ever evolving? How can we expect law not to constrict human freedom and potential? Furthermore, if there is a law, there must be a lawgiver. Matthew Levering argues that natural law theory makes sense only within a broader worldview and that the Bible sketches both such a persuasive worldview and an account of natural law that offers an exciting portrait of the moral life. To establish the relevance of biblical readings to the wider philosophical debate on natural law, this study offers an overview of modern natural law theories from Cicero to Nietzsche, which reverse the biblical portrait by placing human beings at the center of the moral universe. Whereas the biblical portrait of natural law is other-directed, ordered to self-giving love, the modern accounts turn inward upon the self. Drawing on the thought of St. Thomas Aquinas, Levering employs theological and philosophical investigation to achieve a contemporary doctrine of natural law that accords with the biblical witness to a loving Creator who draws human beings to share in the divine life. This book provides both an introduction to natural law theory and a compelling challenge to re-think current biblical scholarship on the topic.

Believing and Acting G. Scott Davis, 2012-03-16. How should religion and ethics be studied if we want to understand what people believe and why they act the way they do? In the 1980s and 90s, postmodernist worries about led to debates that turned on power, truth, and relativism. Since the turn of the century, scholars impressed by cognitive science have introduced concepts drawn from evolutionary biology, neuroscience, and linguistics in the attempt to provide naturalist accounts of religion. Deploying concepts and arguments that have their roots in the pragmatism of C. S. Peirce, *Believing and Acting* argues that both approaches are misguided and largely unhelpful in answering the questions that matter: What did those people believe then? How does it relate to what these people want to do now? What is our evidence for our interpretations? Pragmatic inquiry into these questions recommends an approach that questions grand theories, advocates a critical pluralism about religion and ethics that defies disciplinary boundaries in the pursuit of the truth. Rationality on a pragmatic approach is about solving particular problems in *medias res*; thus, there is no hard and fast line to be drawn between inquiry and advocacy; both are essential to negotiating day-to-day life. The upshot is an approach to religion and ethics in which inquiry looks much like the art history of Michael Baxandall and advocacy like the art criticism of Arthur Danto.

Metaphysics and Gender: The Normative Art of Nature and Its Human Imitations Michele Schumacher, 2023-03-07. The emergent science of transgenerism and related philosophies of gender propose a full-scale inversion of the understanding of God, man, and the created order.

articulated in classical metaphysics undermining and parodying both the causality and ontology voiced by Genesis 1:27. God created man in His own image male and female. He created them. Whether through subversive performative identity or by surgical sex change, the divinely made human person is now threatened with abolition and replacement by the self-made man and the man-made woman. In *Metaphysics and Gender*, Michele M. Schumacher offers a corrective to this distorted and distorting outlook, calling for the recovery of an anthropological vision rooted in recognition of the normative divine art of nature and of the likeness and far greater unlikeness between divine and human causality. Surveying contemporary transgender trends, Schumacher identifies and excavates their conceptual and ideological foundations in the gender theory of Judith Butler, the existentialist feminism of Simone de Beauvoir, and the atheistic existentialism of Jean-Paul Sartre. To the erroneous philosophical presuppositions of these thinkers, Schumacher contrasts the metaphysically grounded thought of Aristotle and Thomas Aquinas, advancing their positive account of the good of creation and of the meaning of ethical norms, human freedom, and natural inclinations and embodiment, and mounting a timely and trenchant defense of the divinely created human person.

**Rethinking Cooperation with Evil** Ryan Connors, 2023-12-15. *Rethinking Cooperation with Evil: A Virtue-Based Approach* applies Thomistic virtue theory to today's most challenging questions of cooperation with evil. For centuries, moralists have struggled to determine the conditions necessary to justify moral cooperation with evil. The English Jesuit Henry Davis even observed: "There is no more difficult question than this in the whole range of Moral Theology." This important book addresses this challenge by applying the virtue-based method of moral reasoning of St. Thomas Aquinas to issues of cooperation with evil. Those who pastor souls report frequently receiving questions from attentive believers about whether a particular human action inadvertently contributes to some moral evil. Examples of potentially immoral cooperation with evil include whether one may shop at a particular franchise known for its support of abortion, whether Catholics may attend civil marriages outside the Church, or whether an organization may submit to government mandates that health insurance include payment for immoral practices. Although recent moralists have tackled specific topics related to cooperation with evil, agreement on an overall common paradigm has not yet been reached. *Rethinking Cooperation with Evil* proposes a method for Christian believers and others to approach these questions from the foundation of the thought of St. Thomas Aquinas and the magisterial teaching of the Catholic Church. This text provides both an overall method for how to understand the issue of cooperation as well as practical counsel for specific cases. *Rethinking Cooperation with Evil* advances the theological conversation on this topic from both speculative and practical vantage points. To facilitate his argument, Connors utilizes historical analyses that contrast Aquinas's method of moral reasoning with that of the casuist treatment of cooperation. Consequently, the book includes numerous case studies that will be of interest both to moral theologians and readers new to the topic.

**Hope and Christian Ethics** David Elliot, 2017-07-14. The theological virtue of hope has long been neglected in Christian ethics. However, as social, civic, and global anxieties mount, the need to overcome despair has
